Heiner Hertling, International Host of PBS Program, *Brush with Nature*, will be demonstrating on Tuesday, October 4th at the general meeting held at 6:30 (demonstration begins approximately at 7:15) at Ella Sharp Museum, 3225 Fourth Street, Jackson and then hosting a *plein aire* workshop, Saturday, October 8th, 2011 from 9-4. We will be painting on location at the Phyllis Haehnle Memorial Audubon Sanctuary in the Waterloo Recreation Area on Seymour Rd. in Jackson County. The 20,000 acre sanctuary of rolling woodland, old pastures, wetland and lakes is a stopover for more than 3,000 migratory Sandhill Cranes, September through November. The sanctuary website is www.haehnlesanctuary.org. It will be an experience to remember! This is a perfect workshop for landscape as well as wildlife artists! This workshop will fill up fast. Heiner will be demonstrating in oil but any medium is welcome. The workshop will be on the concept, planning, and steps taken for plein aire painting.
